The students present their coat of arms.

When the coats of arm are ready the participants sit down together in a circle. Each person shows his or her coat of arms and discusses it in front of the team. Other members have the opportunity to ask questions during the presentation in order to get to know their teammate better.

Coats of arms are hallmarks that were first used to tell apart armies on the battlefield. Later they became signs of people, families, organizations or cities. Coats of arms contain graphic elements that distinguish their owners, define their qualities, refer to their history, and are their recognizable attributes characteristic of them.

The Coat of Arms obliged the knight to abide by the knight's code, which was a set of ethical, moral and professional principles, compliance with which guaranteed a good opinion and a decent life.

Contemporary image of the knight appears as a noble warrior fighting in defense of the weak and oppressed.
